

How to Activate Your Arizona Real Estate License

THE PREREQUISITES

After you've completed 90 hours of pre-licensing education, taken a 6 hour contract writing course, recieved your fingerprint clearance card with the Arizona Department of Public Safety, and passed the Arizona Real Estate Salesperson Exam through Pearson VUE- you're now ready to make your license active!

Submit Your License Application

Log in to the ADRE online portal (www.azre.gov) and upload your documents & pay the application fee:

Once the broker has approved your hire request on ADRE, your license status will show as "Active". You can now represent clients in real estate transactions under your sponsoring brokerage!

- → After joining a brokerage, apply to your local REALTOR® association to gain access to the MLS (Multiple Listing Service), which allows you to view and list properties and access official contract forms. Association options vary by region, so ask your brokerage which one to join.
- → Attend additional training offered by your brokerage
